- 4) Define minor injury and provide an example of what would NOT constitute a minor injury. Please site your reference.

- 5) The minor injury definition is used for children of what age and older?

- 6) If a child recants a previous disclosure of sexual abuse does this indicate the previous findings were inaccurate? Please cite your reference.

- 7) Is medical evidence required to substantiate an allegation of sexual abuse? Why or why not? Please cite your reference.

- 8) Can sexual abuse be substantiated based solely on the victim's disclosure? Why or why not? Please cite your reference.

- 9) What is the difference between a substance-affected infant and a substance-exposed infant? Please cite your reference.

- 10) What drives all decision making?

- 11) What is the best indicator of future behavior?

- 12) A child has been identified as a child trafficking victim. That child is automatically remanded to the custody of DHS, true or false?

- 13) What does policy say regarding PRFC's who use methamphetamine or other stimulants? Please cite your reference.

- 16) Where can you as a supervisor refer staff to find appropriate questions to ask an adult victim of domestic violence, a child victim of domestic violence and a batterer? Please include page number of reference.

- 17) Provide the name and contact information of the certified domestic violence provider(s) within your county of service and of one adjacent county of service.

- 18) Explain the difference between present danger and impending danger. Please cite your reference.

- 19) Describe the five components of the safety threshold criteria? Please cite your reference.

- 20) There are 9 Poor Prognosis Indicators for a FCS case. List 3. Please cite your reference.

- 21) What collaterals are required when assessing the safety of a child with a diagnosed or perceived disability?

- 22) In gathering information for investigations / assessments policy lists seven different types of documentary evidence which should be gathered to gain factual information. Please list at least 3 examples. Please cite your reference.

- 23) When assessing domestic violence, what types of collaterals should you require a specialist to speak with and / or obtain information from prior to approving an assessment of child safety?

- 24) Provide 3 reasons a referral would be assigned as a Priority 1.
- 25) Give an example of a situation that would qualify to be assigned as an assessment.
- 26) If a police officer calls to request a Joint Response what should CANH staff do?
- 27) What is one of the most important questions when taking a referral regarding a possible near death?
- 28) When entering a child death, why is it important to get a good description of what occurred?
- 29) Why is it vital to obtain injury details when entering a referral?
- 30) Give an example of how to disposition a referral, where a PRFC is in Child Care setting slapped a 3 year old in the face, leaving a bruised hand print. The PRFC is still in care of children at the facility.
